## *Caring for your drapes & furnishings*

- Drapes and furnishing fabrics should be cleaned regularly & vacuumed often - Dust, grime, wood and tobacco smoke are hard on furnishing fabrics.
- Protect your drapes from moisture. Humidity and condensation can disturb sizing and dyes in furnishing fabrics and when combined with heat, fumes may cause yellow stains which in most instances cannot be removed by dry cleaning.
- Exposure to Australia's strong sunlight will reduce the life of your furnishings. If possible rotate your drapes to minimise this damage. The backing on insulated drapes will deteriorate with prolonged exposure to sunlight causing the backing to peel, self stick or separate during cleaning.
- Remember, regular cleaning is the key to prolonging the life of your furnishing fabrics.
- Please be aware that a shrinkage rate of 3% can occur on curtain and furnishing fabrics.



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
